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# What we offer

## **The Prevention Service provides support for staff, children, young people and families.**

We offer schools a great way to get support for their staff that have pastoral responsibilities through Pastoral Staff Supervision (Core Offer Plus). We have various levels of supervision to meet your school's needs:

- 11 monthly sessions a year
- six sessions a year
- 90 minute session

One of the Prevention Service's experienced managers will visit your school and provide one to one supervision. The sessions will support your staff in reviewing and further enhancing their skills, knowledge base and effectiveness in many areas.

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## Benefits

The principles of 'whole-family' working and the provision of co-ordinated practical support for schools and their staff have been implemented to manage casework activities, which promotes positive outcomes for children, young people and families.

We offer staff in your school support through one-to-one supervision. Supervision has many benefits. It enables and assures safe, competent and accountable practice, allowing staff to have professional oversight of their work. This ensures that quality services are delivered and positive outcomes are achieved.
