## What we offer

We offer a range of open and bespoke safeguarding training solutions to support schools, early years providers, service leads and practitioners to ensure effective safeguarding procedures are delivered in order to protect and support children.

### **Comprehensive Child Protection Pathway**

A full day course to promote effective safeguarding practices through developing knowledge and skills in relation to the Comprehensive Child Protection Pathway, following the 'Signs of Safety' conferencing model.

This course is aimed at newly appointed Designated Safeguarding Leads and deputies or for staff who have been invited to a case conference, who have never attended before.

### **Comprehensive Child Protection Pathway Refresher**

A half day course to promote effective safeguarding practices through developing knowledge and skills for the Designated Safeguarding Lead and their deputies.

### **Safeguarding Children**

A half day course to update your knowledge of child protection issues, including: definitions, indicators, legislation, guidance, and processes. It can be used as refresher training for Designated Safeguarding Leads and their deputies.

### **Toxic Trio**

This half day course explores the impact on children, young people and parenting when their parents are experiencing specific difficulties: - parental substance misuse; parental mental illness; domestic abuse. It can be used as refresher training for Designated Safeguarding Leads and their deputies.

### **Young People and Risky Behaviour**

This is a full day's classroom training covering a range of risky behaviours and the links to adolescent development. It explores issues relevant to safeguarding young people exhibiting risky behaviours, including self-harm, new psychoactive substances, substance misuse, unsafe relationships, sexual practice, gangs and groups and radicalisation. It can be used as refresher training for Designated Safeguarding Leads and their deputies.

### **Child Sexual Exploitation: Working with those directly at risk of CSE**

This full day course looks at our understanding of Child Sexual Exploitation (CSE), perceptions of victims and perpetrators, how to engage with children and young people at risk of CSE and information and support to ensure preventative and proactive multi agency work. It can be used as refresher training for Designated Safeguarding Leads and their deputies.

### **Whole School Safeguarding Training/ Early Years Setting Safeguarding Training**

This short course will enable you to gain basic knowledge of child abuse and neglect, recognise the signs and symptoms of abuse and how to listen to and support children who are in need of protection. You will also learn how to respond if there are concerns about a child and to recognise the importance of recording concerns.
