

COMHR01: Right to Work

A Right to Work check involves a review of a candidate's legal identification documents to ascertain whether they have permission to work in the UK. These checks are important and must be carried out before any person is employed by any organisation.

The course provides the basic knowledge and understanding needed to carry out Right to Work checks. It covers what they are, why they are important and details the different types of documents used whilst checking peoples right to work in the UK.

- The consequences of failing to conduct these checks
- Describes the eligibility criteria to work in the UK
- Explains the different types of legal documents and what type of check that need to take place
