

## **HSWG33: Managing Electrical Safety Live Overhead and Buried Power Lines**

Contact with power lines and cables can be lethal, whether they are carrying a voltage as high as 400,000 volts or as low as 11000 volts. For this reason, knowledge of how to manage safe working practices with live overhead and buried power lines is absolutely vital.

- How to protect against contact with live overhead power lines
- The precautions that are necessary for safe passage under overhead power lines
- The precautions that are necessary for work under overhead power lines
